HANDING OVER OF GIFTS FROM FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS/ORGANISATIONS AND COMPLETED PROJECTS FUNDED BY/THROUGH THE AUSPICES OF FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS/ORGANISATIONS

- 1. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has the overall responsibility for the coordination of all completed projects funded by or through the auspices of foreign governments/organizations. Hence, the Ministry is responsible for the organization and coordination of handing over formalities, which will include:
 - a. Press coverage;
 - b. Unveiling of the Plaque, when applicable;
 - c. Speeches;
 - d. Invitations; etc.
- 2. Similarly, once a Government Ministry/Department is ready to accept a gift from a Foreign Government/Organization, the former will inform the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the nature of the gift and forward to it all relevant information.
- 3. The Director General/Desk Officer in liaison with Protocol Section will then contact the two parties concerned and fix a mutually agreeable date, time and place for the ceremony to be held.
- 4. The Protocol Section, in liaison with the two parties concerned and the Desk Officer, will inform all those who are to be present at the ceremony of the arrangements made.
 - The Protocol Section will make recommendations with regards to the guest list.
- 5. The Protocol Office will be responsible for organizing and coordinating the ceremonial on the prescribed day.
