

ISSUE OF IDENTITY CARDS

1. *Identity Cards are issued to members of diplomatic missions residing in Seychelles, in the following 3 categories :*
 - (i) *Head of Diplomatic Consular and International Organizations Mission Identity Card.*
 - (ii) *Diplomatic Identity Card - to the spouse of the Head of Mission and all diplomatic agents and their spouse.*
 - (iii) *Technical and Administrative Identity Card - to all other foreign personnel in the consular mission, International Organizations and their spouses.*
2. *The Head of Mission should submit an application for an Identity Card for all members of the Mission, as soon as possible after their arrival in Seychelles.*

The application should be accompanied by two passport size photographs.
3. *Upon receipt of the application, Protocol Section will ensure that :*
 - *The appropriate card, properly numbered is issued.*
4. *The Mission should surrender the card as soon as possible after the completion of the term of office of the holder.*

The Protocol Office is responsible for notifying the Commissioner of Police, PS Immigration, CEO SCAA, Airport Guard Room and Director General Trade Tax Division of all cards issued and surrendered.
